# Downtown Street Performer Permit Application

A representative of a performance group, or an individual performer, is required to file and sign an application, and to hold a street performer permit. Permits must be displayed at all times during your performance. Permits are valid from the date the permit is issued until the end of the calendar year.

- Only battery-operated amplifiers are permitted.
- This request must be reviewed by the Chief of Police and thus performers requesting amplification will receive their permit by mail.
- Street performers using amplification must abide by broadcast regulations outlined in the City ordinance to ensure they do not create a nuisance. This will be strictly enforced.

Please note, this form is an application for your Street Performer Permit ONLY. It is not an approval or proof of acceptance into the Thursday night Street Performer Series. The Series requires a separate application process in the spring.

I understand that this application will be approved, denied or approved with conditions within fifteen (15) days of being filed. I also understand that if granted a permit, I will perform in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Street Performer Ordinance, Article VI, Chapter 32 of the ordinance code of the City of Holland, MI. I understand that if this ordinance is violated, my permit is subject to revocation, and I am subject to ticketing. I also indemnify the City of Holland, its officials, employees and agents from any liability arising (including reasonable attorney fees and costs) out of my street performance. Consent and release for story, likeness, and voice: I give permission to the City of Holland, the City of Holland Mainstreet/Downtown Development Authority, and the City of Holland Downtown Principal Shopping District (collectively referred to as the "Organizations") to use (including but not limited to taking photographs and making audio recordings or videos), without charge and without reservation, all or a portion of my story including my likeness and my voice in promoting these Organizations. I acknowledge that editorial changes may be made as deemed suitable by the Organizations. Whether or not changes are made, I waive any rights of action I may have and release the Organizations from any and all claims I may have arising from the use, publication and changes in the content, including any rights to sue for defamation or violation of rights of privacy or rights of publicity.
